## **Standards**

- Current Events: Students will read the newspaper for articles about food.
- Science: Students will create a flamingo facts crossword puzzle.
- Science: Students will watch videos about flamingo behavior.

## **Activities**

- Use the News: The color of a flamingo's plumage is largely determined by what it eats. As you read the newspaper, what information can you find about our food supply? When you find something, write a one-paragraph summary of the information. Articles may include international grain exports/imports, health information, recipes, food science, etc.
- 2. As you read through the WOW comic, highlight or underline unfamiliar or interesting words. Next, use these words and their definitions to create a flamingo crossword puzzle. The puzzle could be handmade or computer-generated from online puzzle makers, such as <a href="http://www.puzzle-maker.com/crossword\_Design.cgi">http://www.puzzle-maker.com/crossword\_Design.cgi</a>.
- 3. Their upside-down eating technique is very interesting and unique. Can you think of another animal that sifts water in its mouth to eat?
